The Documentary, Experimental & Animation Film Center (DEFC), the largest and sole supporter of documentary, experimental, and animated cinema in Iran, was established in 1984 with the support of the Ministry of Culture and Islamic Guidance. Since its inception, DEFC has independently produced or collaborated with public and private organizations to create more than 1,300 films across documentary, experimental, and animated cinema. Many of these films have been showcased at prestigious international festivals for decades. From 2013 to 2025, DEFC productions have made over 1,167 national and international appearances, earning 530 awards in the process.

Each year, the center hosts two sets of educational events—workshops and masterclasses—one in the summer and the other during the International Iran's Documentary Film Festival.
